Tuition fee reductions for DAAD-
scholarship holders

Introduction and background

The DAAD London, in collaboration with seven UK universities who offer a reduction to DAAD scholarship holders, is running an online information session on the 25th of April 2024. The aim is to target prospective DAAD scholarship holders who are considering applying for a scholarship for studies starting in Autumn 2025. We wish to make these prospective scholarship holders aware of the existence of the Agreements and the tuition fee reductions they provide for.

Key word: **Agreement**, also MoU (Memorandum of Understanding). These Agreements offer a reduction of tuition fees for a German DAAD scholarship holders at the participating university. To be eligible, scholarship holders must be enrolled on a Master's course at one of the participating UK universities. Further exclusions apply with each university – check the terms below.
